1. Nomination

2. Application documents

- ✓ ID photo in either JPG or PNG format
- ✓ Study transcripts in English
- ✓ Proof of language level (B2 required in French or English depending on your programme)
- ✓ Learning agreement
- ✓ Cover letter explaining your motivation to come to ESIEA
- ✓ Photocopy of passport or your ID card
- ✓ Proof of health insurance for the period of study

ACCOMMODATION

ESIEA cooperates with the **CROUS** student halls of residence which is a public organization, and has reserved a limited quota of furnished CROUS rooms.

Please note: the available rooms are offered on first-come, first-served basis, in the order the applications arrive. Due to the limited number of exchange student rooms, please note that applying before the deadline does not guarantee housing at **CROUS**.

In Paris - Ivry-sur-Seine

Two possibilities:

1. The residence hall **CROUS Cachan** is located at about 45 minutes by bus from ESIEA Paris- Ivry Campus. Please note that there are no cooking facilities but there are university restaurant facilities nearby. Bedding is not provided.
2. The residence hall **CROUS Kremlin-Bicêtre** is located at about 15 minutes by metro from ESIEA Paris- Ivry Campus. This residence was opened in January 2019 and the rooms have a private bathroom and a small kitchen. Bedding is not provided.

<p>Insurance</p>	<p>All students must show proof of French housing insurance upon arrival to cover accidental damage caused by the tenant or by natural disasters: flooding, storm etc...</p> <p>They also have to take out public-liability insurance which covers them in case of damage to a third person.</p> <p>This is generally included in the housing insurance, but this needs to be verified. French companies like SMEBA, LMDE or banks offer such insurance policies.</p>

<p>Cost of housing</p>	<p>In Paris</p> <p>CROUS Cachan Campus (near Paris): 263 €/ month for a room, utilities included. 233 € deposit</p> <p>Please note that there are no cooking facilities but there are university restaurant facilities nearby</p> <p>CROUS Kremlin-Bicêtre 450 €/ month for a room, utilities included. 233 € deposit</p> <p>Private housing In Paris The rent per month is between €700 and €900</p> <p>In Laval:</p> <p>1 year lease – CROUS studio apartment 275 €/ month + utilities (about 30 €/ month) ~ 200 € deposit</p> <p>Semester lease – private studio apartment housing solution ~ 400 – 500 €/ month ~ 200 € deposit</p>

<p>What to do on arrival?</p> <p>Visa/ immigration procedures</p>	<p>Students must come to the International Office as soon as they arrive.</p> <p>Students with a long stay student visa (“D”) (non-Europeans), must send to the OFII (French Office for Immigration and Integration) the form called “demande d’attestation OFII” given by the French embassy along with a copy of passport, visa and the date of arrival on French territory.</p>
